Scholarship Application Form

For Graduating Eighth-Grade Students from
All Saints Catholic School or Saint Joseph's Catholic Academy

Purpose: The Catholic Woman's Club (CWC) Scholarship Award will be given to two graduating 8th-grade students who have excelled academically and/or have demonstrated outstanding leadership ability in school, Church or community. The scholarships will be for \$1000 each. The money will be applied to the winners' tuition at St. Joseph's Catholic Academy for their freshman year of high school.

Eligibility: The student must

1. Be an 8th-grade student from All Saints Catholic School or Saint Joseph's Catholic Academy who has registered to attend St. Joseph's Catholic Academy in the fall.
2. Have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.00 (or B).
3. Have demonstrated commitment to youth service through a combination of community involvement, extra-curricular activities in Church or school and academic achievement.
4. Must be a resident of Kenosha County.

Scholarship Requirements:

1. **Complete and sign application form.**
 - ❖ Entire form must be completed by the student or the application will **not** be considered for the award. It is acceptable to write "none" if a section of the application does not apply to you. (e.g.: if you do not participate in any sports programs, write "none" or "I'm not involved in sports", but don't leave that line blank!)
 - ❖ All responses on this application **MUST** be legibly handwritten by the student– **NOT** typed.
2. **Register at St. Joseph's Catholic Academy for the next school year, 2018 - 2019.** (We will have proof of registration.)
3. **Submit ONE letter of recommendation from an 8th-grade teacher, school counselor or school principal. This is very important.** This letter should be personalized to the student to demonstrate knowledge of the student's abilities and achievements. It should not be a "form" letter.
4. **Enclose a copy of your most recent report card.** Attach any comments and GPA, including any codes for comments and grades.

The Catholic Woman's Club Scholarship Award Selection Committee will review applications and decisions of the board are final.

Scholarship Decision:

The scholarship award winners will be announced at an appropriate ceremony. Certificates will be awarded to the winners at the CWC annual luncheon in May. Scholarship money will be sent to St. Joseph's Catholic Academy to be applied to the winners' tuition. (\$500 to the first semester and \$500 to the second semester tuition.)
