All Saints Catholic School COVID-19 Plan Summary

Masks

- The wearing of masks will be optional for staff and students.
- A federal order is now in place that requires face coverings for public transportation; this includes school bus transportation. Students will be required to wear face coverings on school buses. This federal order remains in effect until revoked.
- Reminder to be respectful of the choices of others. Bullying of students/staff with or without masks will not be tolerated.

Students Testing Positive for COVID

- Students will follow the Kenosha County Health Department recommendations which require the individual testing positive to quarantine from school and all school activities for ten (10) days from the onset of symptoms.
- Students may only return to school after ten (10) days and having no symptoms.
- Absence will be excused. See below for quarantine instruction procedures.

Close Contact and Quarantine Procedures

- ASCS will continue to contact trace for an individual testing positive for COVID. ASCS will use fifteen (15) minutes at three (3) feet as the close contact time/distance.
- Families of students will be contacted and notified that their child has been identified as a close contact and are encouraged to monitor their symptoms. ***This communication will be sent by email.***
 - All students will receive this notification regardless of their vaccination status.
- Close contacts:
 - Students identified as close contacts:
 - If a student is showing **NO symptoms**, they **will not be excluded** from school; students will be allowed to remain in school without missing any school or school activities.
 - If symptoms develop within ten (10) days of last contact with the individual testing positive, the individual will be required to quarantine.
 - Students identified as a close contact AND showing symptoms will be required to quarantine for ten (10) days. They may return to school earlier with a negative COVID-19 test result, physician clearance and/or no symptoms.
 - Families may elect to quarantine their child and the absence will be excused. See below for quarantine instruction procedures.

Quarantine Instruction

- **Quarantined classes/grades** will move to virtual instruction and will receive instruction from the teacher.
- **Individuals** who are quarantined will follow a general absence procedure, working with the teacher to understand assignments/work due.
- Students should email teachers for assistance and/or questions. Students in middle school should reach out to their homeroom teacher to inquire about possible synchronous learning during their isolation period.
- Upon return, students shall meet with the teacher to make up any work/assessments that could not be completed while out of school.

Instructional Model

- ASCS will provide in-person instruction five (5) days a week.

Social Distancing

- Social distancing will be provided as available.
- Teachers will incorporate collaborative/group activities; during these activities social distancing will not always be possible.

Health Service Protocols

- Frequent hand washing/sanitizing is encouraged.
- Continued nightly cleaning of frequently touched surfaces.

COVID-19 Vaccine

- All Saints Catholic School will not mandate the COVID-19 vaccine for our faculty, staff or students.
- Consistent with our Catholic teaching, we believe decisions for our children should be made in the home by the parents.
- ASCS will not use an individual's vaccine status to determine employment, enrollment or eligibility to participate in school functions/events, nor does it influence quarantine procedures.

The protocols and procedures in this document will continue to be monitored as well as COVID-related data including, but not limited to, positive tests and the number of individuals identified as a close contact. Significant increases in these numbers may result in changes to this plan.
